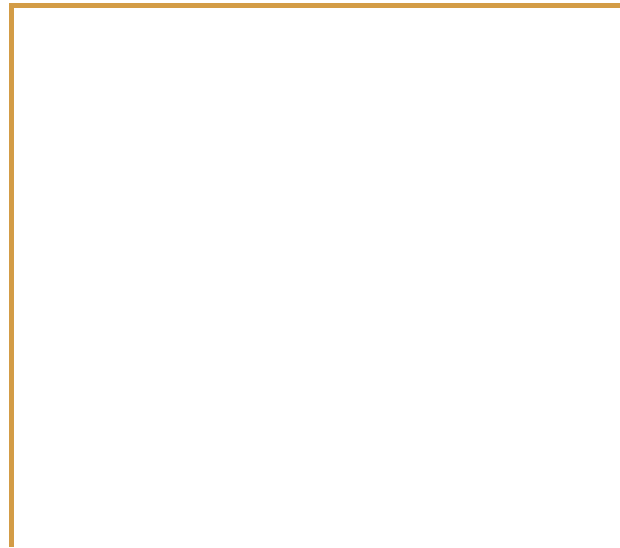
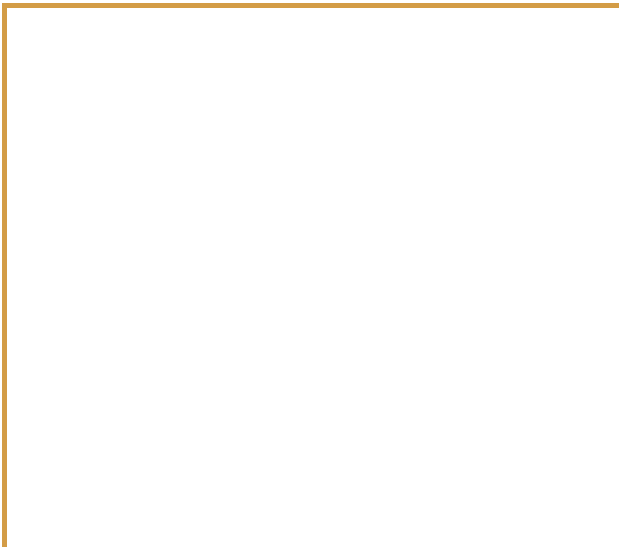


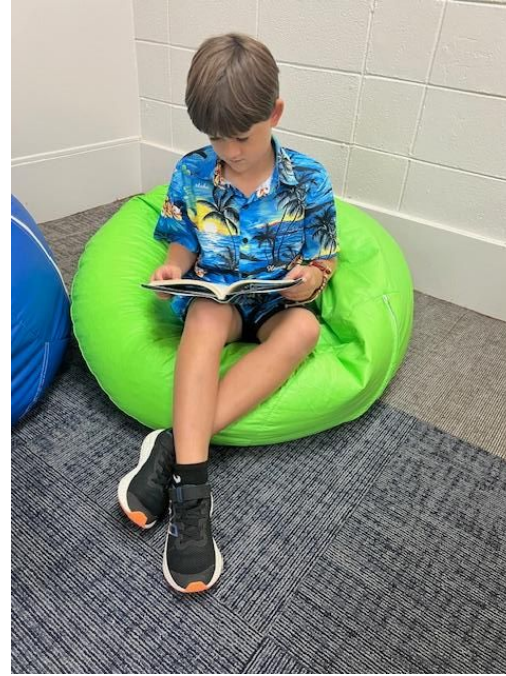
Thank you Burgess and McCullough Family

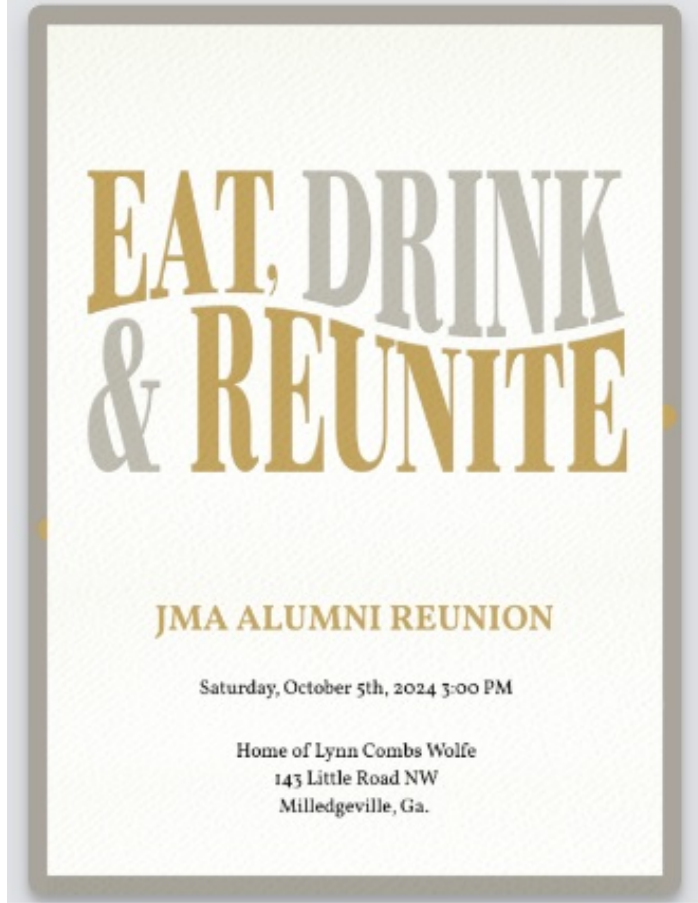

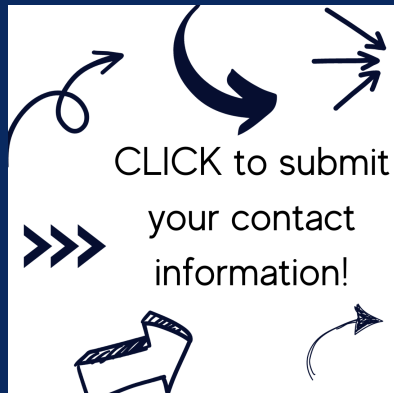
