The food bank says of that population, about 106,000 (one in seven) are food insecure and about 38,000 are children. 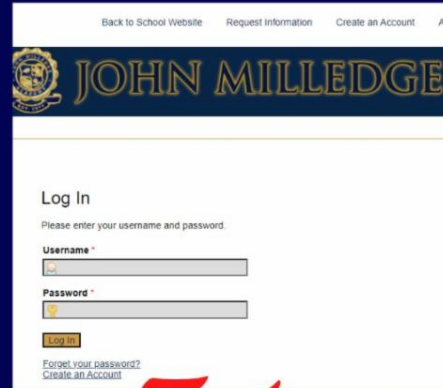

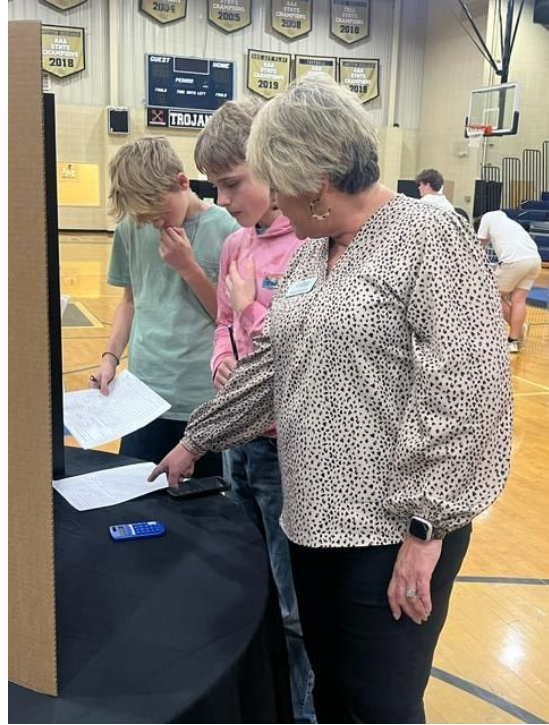
